Meeting Called to Order: 6:06pm

Approve Minutes: Approved

- Meeting minutes from the last meeting were approved without opposition.

Sponsorship and Community Partners

- Exploration of new basketball sponsorship opportunities is underway. Three sponsors from the football season will be invited to participate in the basketball season.

Financial Updates

- A sponsorship for the senior dinner was received, covering most expenses. Storage unit fees increased by \$10 due to insurance requirements. The booster club's current balance is approximately \$20,169.59.

Tax Credit and Competition Team Financial Updates

- Tax credit donations have raised \$3,000 from nine donors for competition fees. The competition team has \$2,591 remaining in fees, with \$89.34 per athlete.

Nationals Trip Details

- Nationals trip is scheduled from Thursday to Sunday, with a potential Disney visit on Sunday. Parents have the option to attend and support the team. More details to come in December regarding more Competition details.

Double Good Popcorn Fundraiser

- Fundraiser starts November 24 and runs for one week. Sales code will be distributed this week.

Coaches' Gifts

- A gift card drive is planned for Coaches' Christmas gifts. Previous gifts included cozy baskets and gift cards.

TSC Event Planning

- Event is planned as a two-day event but may be reduced to one day. Food trucks and facilities are booked for two days. Volunteer scheduling will be finalized once the event duration is confirmed.
